100% of All Students will increase student growth by one percentile ranking every 3 months in Mathematics by 06/07/2019 as measured by AIMSWEB math computation probe.

Strategy 1:

Math Across the Curriculum - Oxford Crossroads Day School staff will implement mathematical/problem-solving skills throughout the curriculum. The skills of equation building, problem-solving, inquiry, and discovery skills are to be implemented in all classes throughout the school year. The analysis and synthesis of chart and graph data as well as the solving real world problems within each content area will support the math curriculum
